PRESENTATION OF THE CONGRESS

Held every two years in a different country, the international congresses on dry stone have been organized, with various partnerships, in Croatia, Greece, Italy, France, Spain, Switzerland, United Kingdom, Morocco) and have always mobilized a large audience, coming from Europe, the Middle East, the United States, Australia.

The main objectives of these congresses are to disseminate knowledge about dry stone construction conceived as a traditional art ; to develop and conduct research and practical work in this field ; to facilitate the exchange of experience of good practices for the construction and the maintenance of dry stone structures. The art of dry stone (knowledge and techniques) is listed in the intangible world heritage of UNESCO in 2018

These objectives concern specialists and actors in the fields of :

- research in anthropology, history, geography, agronomy, earth and nature sciences, architecture, environmental and territorial engineering

- the application of technology to construction and regional planning, the training of craftsmen and the advice to users

- the planning and awareness for evolutions of the built heritage, the landscapes, the environment


- the development of green and/or cultural tourism.

The scientific and technical field covered by these different approaches is very broad and suitable for any theme. Formalized in 1998, the Society perpetuates these congresses, follows the research and applications of the technique and maintains the link between the different partners.
